



Terms and Conditions for the Airport Design Competition

1. Eligibility: - The competition is open to high school students from Gauteng, the Western Cape, and Limpopo. - Each participating team may consist of up to five learners, with no more than two accompanying educators. - Only one team may register with each school.

2. Registration: - Schools must complete and submit a formal application by the specified deadline. - Teams must provide a brief overview of their design concept, including objectives and inspiration.

3. Submission Guidelines: -

Phase 1: Teams must submit the required application forms and design concept overview by the designated deadline.

Phase 2: Digital submissions must be created using approved 3D modelling software and include annotations detailing key features of their designs.

Phase 3: Only the top three teams will be invited to create and present physical models at the designated venue.

4. Judging Criteria: - Design submissions will be evaluated based on creativity, feasibility, adherence to theme, presentation clarity, and potential community impact.

5. Prizes: - Outstanding prizes will be awarded to the top three teams, with special recognition for the winning team. Details on prize specifics will be provided as the competition continues.

6. Intellectual Property: - By entering the competition, teams grant GFA the right to use their designs for promotional purposes and as static display at GFA's aerospace centre

7. Conduct and Ethics: - Participants are expected to uphold the highest standards of integrity and teamwork. Plagiarism or unethical behaviour will result in disqualification. - Teams must collaborate with respect and ensure that all contributions are acknowledged.

8. Liability: - The organisers are not liable for any injury, loss, or damage incurred during the competition or related activities. Participants engage at their own risk.

9. Amendments: - GFA reserves the right to amend the competition rules and guidelines as necessary. Participants will be notified of any significant changes.

10. Dispute Resolution: Any disputes arising from the competition will be addressed by the organising committee, whose decisions will be final.



11. Acceptance of Terms: - By participating in the competition, all teams and participants agree to abide by these terms and conditions. Please note that these terms and conditions are suggestions and should be tailored to meet the specific needs and legal requirements of GFA
